- Sola Gratia: By Freely Choosing to Give the Ungodly the Gift of His Grace Alone! Isaiah 48:11; Deuteronomy 7:5-8; 1Corinthians 1:26-31; Romans 9:14-18
- Christus Solus: By Graciously Exchanging Their Sin for His Righteousness in Christ Alone! Romans 5:19, 21; 3:23-24; 16:25-27; Jude 25; 2Corinthians 5:21
- Sola Fide: By Justly Declaring the Ungodly to Be Justified by Faith Alone! Romans 3:21-23; 4:20; 5:17
- Sola Scriptura: By Uniquely Revealing This Good News According to Scripture Alone! Romans 3:21; 16:25-27; 10:14-17
- Soli Deo Gloria: By Completely Ensuring that All the Glory Goes to Him alone! Jeremiah 9:23-24; 1Corinthians 1:26-31; Romans 15:17-18; Galatians 6:14-15; 1Corinthians 3:21-23; 4:7; 2Corinthains 12:9; 15:9-11; Ephesians 2:8-10

Westminster Shorter Catechism

Question: What is the chief end of man?

Answer: Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.

Cambridge Declaration

We reaffirm that because salvation is of God and has been accomplished by God, it is for God's glory and that we must glorify Him always. We must live our entire lives before the face of God, under the authority of God and for his glory alone. We deny that we can properly glorify God if our worship is confused with entertainment, if we neglect either Law or Gospel in our preaching,

or if self-improvement, self-esteem or self-fulfillment are allowed to become alternatives to the gospel.

To God Alone Be the Glory!

Romans 11:33-36

What Is Romans 11:33-36?

A DOXOLOGY: Delighting in giving God the glory He deserves in word, in song, and in life!

Our theology should sing like a hymn, not read like a telephone book!

Why Is Romans 11:33-36 Here?

To remind us that **THEOLOGY** should always lead to doxology: God's glory-showing requires glory-giving!

Four Reasons Why God Alone Gets All the Glory for Our Salvation

1. God's WILL in Saving the Underserving Is Unfathomable! Romans 11:33a

Oh, My God! The MERCY of Your riches is unfathomable! Romans 2:4; 9:22-23; 10:12-13; 11:2; Ephesians 1:5-9, 17-19; 2:4-6 Oh, My God! The <u>MYSTERY</u> of Your wisdom is unfathomable! Romans 1:21-25; 11:25; 12:16

Why Is God's Wisdom in Saving Us an Unfathomable Mystery?

- 1) Because God's wisdom in salvation is <u>CONCEALED</u> in Christ! Colossians 1:27; 2:2
- 2) Because God's wisdom in salvation was **DISPLAYED** on the cross! 1Corinthians 1:18-25; 2:6-10
- 3) Because God's wisdom in salvation is **PREDESTINED** for whomever He chooses! Ephesians 1:5-9, 17-18
- 4) Because God's wisdom in salvation is **REVEALED** to everyone by His Word through His Church! *Ephesians 3:8-10*
- Oh, My God! The MAJESTY of Your knowledge is unfathomable! Romans 8:29; 11:2; See also 1:18-21, 32; 2:2-4, 17-24; 3:17-19; 6:3, 16; 7:1; 10:2; 11:2; 15:14
- 2. God's WAYS in Saving the Underserving Are Untraceable! Romans 11:33b
 - Oh, My God! The judgments of Your sovereign purposes are UNSEARCHABLE!
 - Oh, My God! The ways of Your saving plan are UNTRACEABLE!

3. God's WORTHINESS in Saving the Underserving Is Unmatchable! Romans 11:34-35

Our Unworthiness Compared to His Worthiness

- Who Am I? Do I really think I can out-think God and figure out His MIND? "For who has known the mind of the Lord..."
- Who am I? Do I really think I can out-maneuver God and give Him <u>ADVICE</u>? "or who became His counselor?"
- Who Am I? Do I really think I can out-give God and make Him my <u>DEBTOR</u>? "Or who has first given to Him that it might be paid back to him again?"

4. God's WORSHIP for Saving the Underserving Is Unbeatable! Romans 11:36

- Solution Content for all things are from God: You are the SOURCE of all things!
- Glory to God Alone! For all things are through God: You are the SUSTAINER of all things!
- Solver all things are for God: You are the Sovereign over all things!

Delight in Giving God the Glory He Alone Deserves!

"To Him be the glory forever! Amen! It is true! Let it be!"

"It is because all things are from, through and to God that the glory must be His alone. This is why human pride is so offensive. Pride is behaving as if we were God Almighty, strutting around the earth as if we owned the place, repudiating our due dependence on God, pretending instead that all things depend on us, and thus arrogating to ourselves the glory which belongs to God alone." – John Stott
