Lesson Four • 1Corinthians 7:25-38 Singleness Redeemed for Radical Devotion

**Guard Against Idolatry** 

Don't look to marriage or singleness for your <u>IDENTITY</u>. Identity is not found in our marital status but in our redemptive status.

### **Good Advice to Singles**

You are free in Christ to consider <u>MARRIAGE</u> one of your goals or to consider <u>SINGLENESS</u> your assignment from the Lord.

Now concerning virgins: I have no commandment from the Lord; yet I give judgment as one whom the Lord in His mercy has made trustworthy. 1Corthinians 7:25

But even if you do marry, you have not sinned; and if a virgin marries, she has not sinned. 1Corinthians 7:28

Let him do what he wishes; he does not sin; let them marry. 1Corinthians 7:36

So then he who gives her in marriage does well, but he who does not give her in marriage does better. 1Corinthians 7:38

And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may serve the Lord without distraction. 1Corinthians 7:35

### **Redeeming Singleness for Radical Devotion**

### 1. Recognize the ASSURANCES of Being Single!

### **Divine Assurances of Singleness**

Singleness is <u>GOOD</u>.

But I say to the unmarried and to the widows: It is good for them if they remain even as I am. 1Corinthians 7:8

I suppose therefore that this is good because of the present distress—that it is good for a man to remain as he is. 1Corinthians 7:26

Singleness is God's <u>GIFT</u>.

For I wish that all men were even as I myself. But each one his his own gift from God, one in this manner and another in that. 1Corinthians 7:7

Singleness is for God's <u>GLORY</u>.

## 2. Maximize the <u>ADVANTAGES</u> of Being Single!

#### Missional Advantages of Singleness

More freedom to COPE with present distress and pressures.

I suppose therefore that this is good because of the present distress—that it is good for a man to remain as he is: Are you bound to a wife? Do not seek to be loosed. Are you loosed from a wife? Do not seek a wife. But even if you do marry, you have not sinned; and if a virgin marries, she has not sinned. Nevertheless such will have trouble in the flesh, but I would spare you. ICorinthians 7:26-28

> More freedom to MAINTAIN an eternal perspective and priorities.

But this I say, brethren, the time is short, so that from now on even those who have wives should be as though they had none, those who weep as though they did not weep, those who rejoice as though they did not rejoice, those who buy as though they did not possess, and those who use this world as not misusing it. For the form of this world is passing away. 1Corinthians 7:29-31

More freedom to SERVE the Lord with undivided affection and attention.

But I want you to be without care. He who is unmarried cares for the things of the Lord—how he may please the Lord. But he who is married cares about the things of the world—how he may please his wife. There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world—how she may please her husband. And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may serve the Lord without distraction. 1Corinthians 7:32-35
