Lesson Two

#### Our Struggle in the Prison of Unforgiveness

- > Forgive him? Are you serious? After what he has done to me? I can *never* forgive him!
  - Forgive me? How could God forgive me? You don't *know* what I have done!
  - > How could I have done such an awful thing? I can *never* forgive myself!

As Christ followers we have a moral imperative from our Lord to <u>RECOVER</u> the lost art of forgiveness.

"Forgiveness is a freeing, empowering, refreshing, healing, and joyful experience, which is capable of transforming all of life." –Understanding and Facilitating Forgiveness

### 6 Symptoms of an Unforgiving Spirit

- 1) You can't stand to be around certain people.
- 2) You want to strike out at people when certain subjects are discussed.
- You lose your temper over little things.
  "There is a chronic anger that grows from the failure to forgive and there is an anger that festers beneath the failure to seek or accept forgiveness." – Understanding and Facilitating Forgiveness
- 4) You struggle with guilt over things that happened in the past.
- 5) You find yourself hating the ones you should love the most.
- 6) You find your mental, emotional, and physical health failing for uncommon reasons.

# Recovering the Lost Art of Being Set Free by Forgiveness 1. <u>DEFINING</u> the Lost Art of Being Set Free by Forgiveness.

What Forgiveness is NOT!

- Forgiveness is not a <u>FEELING</u>.
- > Forgiveness is *not* <u>FORGETTING</u>.
- Forgiveness is not EXCUSING or DENYING.
- Forgiveness is not <u>IGNORING</u>.
- Forgiveness is not necessarily <u>TRUSTING or RECONCILING</u>.

Forgiveness is hard enough work without assuming the fruitless burden of unbiblical definitions and impossible expectations! In fact, understanding what forgiveness is NOT actually lightens the burden.

#### What Forgiveness IS!

Forgiveness is a <u>DECISION</u> with four essentials.

The decision to set someone free from an obligation to you, that is a result of a wrong done against you, with the promise to never remember it against them in the future.

Four Essentials to Forgiveness - Matthew 18:21-35

- 1) **CONFESSING** that *a wrong has been done*.
- 2) **UNDERSTANDING** that **a debt is now owed**.
- 3) **CHOOSING** to cancel the debt that owed.
- 4) **KEEPING** a promise to never come back for later payment.
- > Forgiveness *is* a CHOICE we make.
- Forgiveness *is* a <u>GIFT</u> we give.
- Forgiveness *is* a <u>PROMISE</u> we make.
  Love "does not take into account a wrong suffered" 1Corinthians 13:5 (NAS)
  - 1) I won't bring it up to the **PERSON** to use against them.
  - 2) I won't bring it up to **OTHERS** to use against them.
  - 3) I won't bring it up to **MYSELF** to use against them.
  - 4) I won't let it be an **OBSTACLE** to viewing them as God views me in Christ.

## 2. DISCERNING Who the Hostage Is that Needs to Be Set Free in Christ.


Forgiveness is the supernatural talent, sacred skill, and spiritual discipline of setting ourselves and others free in Christ for God's glory, their good, and our joy!

What Happens When We Choose to Not Forgive?

- We feel <u>REJECTED</u> and <u>RESENTFUL</u>.
- We choose to WITHHOLD ACCEPTANCE (or WHATEVER the Other Person WANTS/NEEDS from Us).
- We wait for our <u>CONDITIONS</u> to be met.
- We become a <u>BITTER ROOT</u>.
